DISTRICT SUMMER SPORTS 2022

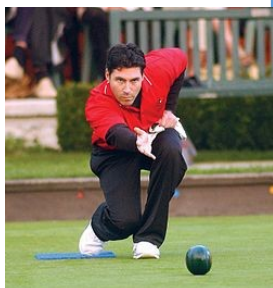
CROQUET and CROWN GREEN BOWLING
